## Please return our equipment on time

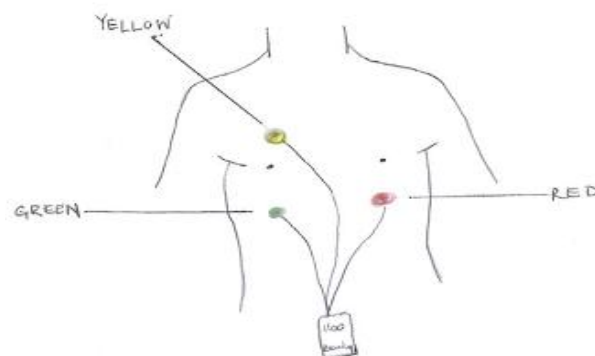
On a daily basis monitors are returned late. This results in:
